Dear Mr Ainsworth,

Your reply to the very serious matters raised in our letter dated 7th October 2005 is nothing short of shocking and disgraceful. You have totally ignored the extremely serious issues that concern the citizens of Coventry and about which you were asked to represent us.

There is something very sinister going on when our local MP ignores the following facts:

- That 11 deaths have occurred with an overcrowding policy imposed by Hospital Trust managers against strong advice against overcrowding by doctors and nurses.
- Concealment of documents relating to a second death, after having denied that they ever existed.
- Suspension of Dr Mattu after whistle-blowing about patient deaths following the Trust management dishonestly denying placement of any seriously ill patients as the 5th patient and hostile rejection that any deaths had ever occurred.
- Maintenance of Dr Mattu's suspension for 4 years at a cost of millions of pounds to the taxpayer.
- Reprisals against Dr Mattu that have destroyed his career and research at a time when he was in his prime and at the top of his field.

I hope you will now reply to our recent letter and the points raised here, and not try to brush away the very serious matter of the deaths accompanying the overcrowding policy imposed on the doctors and nurses by the Trust managers.

Could you please also explain why you have made the untrue claim that you have "been threatened with legal action by him for even investigating the matter"?

You know full well that you publicly made false accusations against Dr Mattu and that it was in response to that that he involved his lawyers and you were forced to make an apology and withdraw your claim. We look forward to your response by return.
